Your responsibilities extend to offering guidance during adjustments to illness, life transitions, and the progression of illnesses. You will engage in vital goals of care discussions, communicate with behavioral health providers, and collaborate closely with navigation team counterparts to ensure holistic care for your client.

Responsibilities:

- Provide compassionate and empathetic emotional support to individuals coping with health transitions and adjustments to illness by providing in-person and virtual check-ins
- Meet with clients in a variety of settings including: private residences, Assisted Living Facilities, Skilled Nursing Facilities, group homes, community shelters, and day centers to provide person-to-person support
- Perform comprehensive assessment of participants' behavioral health needs, including the use of evaluation tools (Geriatric Depression Scales, PHQ-9, etc...)
- Establish behavioral health objectives with clients and set goals to monitor and support actions steps towards accomplishing goals on a 30-60-90 day basis
- Collaborate with psychiatrists, primary care physicians, and various care settings to reconcile medications and ensure alignment between our clients' mental health needs and the adherence of treatment plans and recommendations
- Establish collaborative relationships with external behavioral health entities, such as sobriety homes, treatment facilities, and community mental health centers.
- Monitor and manage referrals to behavioral health agencies through e-mail/phone correspondence.
- Participate actively in multidisciplinary team meetings to provide a comprehensive view of the client's well-being.
- Work closely with your navigation team counterparts to share insights into mental health needs that impact a patient's plan of care
- · Document encounters and case updates in a timely manner
